Are you interested in Agility?

Agility is a fast-paced dog sport, with the main aim being to work through a sequence of obstacles together at speed. Agility enhances your relationship with your dog, and helps both yours, and your dog's fitness. Dogs of most breeds and sizes can participate in agility. They all enjoy

blasting through tunnels, making their way over jumps, and clambering up the A-frame. Dogs do need to be 14 months or over to start training in agility. This is to ensure their bones and joints have fully developed. Agility is an exciting, energetic, fun dog sport, allowing dogs to exercise their brain, and their bounce. FLYBALL

Its a busy time of year for the Torpedoes. We organised the Flyball Fling comp held as part of the Boorowa Irish Wool Festival on 30 September, and are organising a comp at the club being held on 10 November for TDTC's Open Night. But the biggest news for flyball is the outstanding performance of our teams at the National Flyball Championships on 15 and 16 September in Kiama; Launching Torpedoes ran well, coming second in their division. Screaming Torpedoes, after a weekend of very close racing, won their division, bringing home the Nationals trophy for their efforts (its nice to see it in the TDTC clubhouse again).

The Torpedoes have also competed recently at the following comps:

- Cool Runnings in Penrith on 4 August, placing first in their division
- Boorowa Flyball Fling on 30 September, with

Screaming Torpedoes placing second in their division and Opening Torpedoes placing third in their division

- Goulburn Spring Fling, placing first in their division.

Flyball training at TDTC happens on Monday nights at 6:30 pm, weather permitting. Dogs need to be at least 10 months of age to commence flyball training at TDTC and have completed the beginner's obedience course (or equivalent). If you are interested in starting flyball training, please email tdtcflyball@tpg.com.au. Any breed of dog, that is fit and healthy, can do flyball. We like the big dogs for the speed and the little dogs for keeping the jump heights low. It can help to have a dog that already likes tennis balls, but if you would like to do flyball and your dog is not interested in tennis balls, they can still do flyball.
